Match Secretary Update - April 2025

We are well underway in the season now and just wanted to mention a few things. Every Wednesday White Tee Sweep has a best gross payout and for every Saturday Medal a best gross and 2nd place will be rewarded with a sweep payout.

As we are now back entering scores via the PSI terminal and via various apps on your phones and tablets i just wanted to remind you that when asked for the markers name you cannot add a non RMMGC members name to the system.

When this issue arises simply use my name and highlight on your scorecard that you did this and hopefully Club Systems will finally resolve this known bug soon.

A reminder that the cutoff for entering all RMMGC knockouts is Sunday 13th April at 18:00hrs, cost is £2 for each entrant, pay close attention to the age or handicap restrictions for any knockout you are entering.

Of course the Miami, Lindsay and Club Championships are automatically entered via qualification on the confirmed dates in the fixture list.

Also note the knockouts that are selected for the RMMGC finals day on Sunday 24th August, every effort should be made to make yourself available for the finals day, last year was a great day with an excellent turnout to watch the various finals being played.

I've attached the knockout entry rules so you can clearly see the entry conditions and the finals day knockouts.

All 18 hole competitions that are run by the RMMGC carry a mandatory £1 entry fee with an optional £1 sweep.

I notice that several members enter the Wednesday Sweep competition and elect not to enter the sweep, which is great for the club and is well received, however, the point of the sweep is exactly that, to win the sweep.

This obviously also counts towards your handicap and gives you the benefit of a PCC (Playing Course Condition) when more than 10 people play a counting round in any competition.

You could elect to simply play a general round free of charge, however, I would prefer everyone that enters would participate in the sweep also.

The St Andrews interclub match is fast approaching and i've put up an entry sheet on the gents noticeboard for those that are interested. The cost will be £45 per person which includes coffee and bacon roll, 1 x round on either of the courses (TBA) a 2 course dinner and the bus there and back.

This is a 24 man team event and a jacket and tie are expected for the evening meal.

You should note that if you intend to drive yourself and others to the event the cost remains the same so we can fully pay for the bus hire.
